## Clerk's Report –December 2023

## 1. Highways Issues

- a. Church Lane Overgrown Hedge reported to SCC (438717) has been chased up but not been inspected yet.
- b. Hall Road damaged sign ESBC has removed but not reinstalled yet.
- c. Moreton Lane signage Still no response from SCC on this.
- d. Blocked gully on Silver Lane was attended by SCC Contractors on 4<sup>th</sup> October chased up with SCC Highways and told a camera survey is required but no date set for this.

## e. Potholes

- Woodlands Wren Park potholes reported (4533243, 4353239, 4535238) and chased up. SCC have not inspected yet due to flooding issues taking priority. Clerk has contacted Cllr Atkins for help with these issues.
- ii. Bag Lane has been reported to SCC Highways again (4351666) and chased up. Trevor has highlighted the issue again with the inspector.
- iii. Church Lane edge of road has been reported to SCC Highways (438717)
- iv. Marchington Cliff –jobs raised (2314429 & 2314435) chased up again told that not scheduled yet due to commitments with winter gritting.
