1. Highways Issues

- a. Church Lane Overgrown Hedge reported to SCC (438717) has been chased up again. Clerk to check with SCC Highways if it is permitted for handyman to attend to this.
- b. Hall Road damaged sign ESBC has removed but not reinstalled yet has been chased up and expecting response w/c 8th January.
- c. Blocked gully on Silver Lane has been chased up with SCC Highways again.
- d. Blocked gullies on Bag Lane have been reported (4343715 & 4343716) Amey have responded that these are not considered urgent.
- e. Potholes
 - i. Woodlands Wren Park potholes reported (4533243, 4353239, 4535238) these have been repaired.
 - ii. Bag Lane Pothole has been repaired but reported again because deteriorating again already.
 - iii. Church Lane edge of road has been reported to SCC Highways (438717) and chased up.
 - iv. Marchington Cliff –jobs raised (2314429 & 2314435) has been chased up again.

2. Footpath Issues

- a. FP2 (railway line) Blocked by fallen tree branches Handyman still to do.
- 3. **Silver Lane Noticeboard** Awaiting installation by the handyman when the weather improves.
- 4. **Severn Trent** MP is looking into this for the Parish Council.
- 5. **Flood Warden Training** has been arranged for 18th January 9am-12 noon at the village hall. Thirteen volunteers have confirmed they will attend. If anyone else would like to join this session please let the clerk know.
- 6. **Flood Recovery Framework Grant** information has been received from ESBC & SCC and forwarded to residents affected by the flooding during Storm Babet.

- 8. **Permissive Path Project** Chair and clerk are progressing with the application for a permissive path.
