Extra highways crews are back on a mission to fix more roads.

The county council announced back in May that it would be investing heavily in our roads, and I am pleased to see this work continuing in our local area. The work these extra crews are doing will make such a difference to the people who live and work, and will create improved journeys for everyone. Since May, nearly 30,000 potholes have been filled, with over 53,000 gullies cleared in 2024, nearly 20% more than in 2023.

The crews will also do their best to minimise any disruption. Many of our local residents have told me how important having good roads is to them, so hopefully with the work going on in our area, we'll see a massive improvement in the conditions of our roads.

Staffordshire County Council's highways crew will be in the areas below over the next week, carrying out pothole repairs and tackling drainage issues. These extra crews are the result of a nearly £8 million investment the county council is making into Staffordshire's roads, to help repair the damage done by one of the wettest winters on record, and to ensure they are prepared for next winter. This is in addition to the £30 million investment the county council is making in maintaining and improving Staffordshire's highways over the next two years, alongside a total of £53 million being spent on a range of major projects, vital road improvements and general road maintenance in 24/25.
